Directions

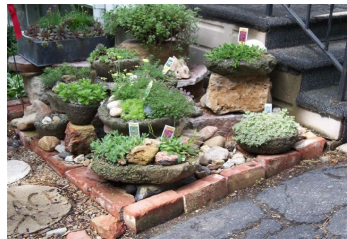

Turn right at the 4th stop light onto Dupuy Road VSU is 1/2 mile on the left; turn left at the stadium entrance.
