

Newport News Master Gardeners Association Horticulture Grant 2024-25 School Year

Purpose

Newport News Master Gardeners Association (NNMGA) Horticulture Grants are designed to foster and support the development of student-based projects within both public and private Newport News schools that reflect the Virginia Master Gardener mission of enhancing horticultural awareness and the environment. These grants are designed to provide seed money for on campus projects that increase student understanding and appreciation of the role of plants and gardening in the local ecosystem and on their campus. Student-centered and hands-on projects are strongly encouraged.

Eligibility

Grants are available to teachers of all content areas in both public and private schools in Newport News. All levels of schools are eligible to apply for the grants.

Size of Grants

NNMGA Horticulture Grants may be funded up to \$500.

Application Timeline

Applications can be found at <u>nnmastergardeners.org</u>. Completed applications may be submitted either electronically or by mail and are due by May 1st, 2024. Approval of grants will be announced by June 15, 2024, and funds will be made available on August 15, 2024.

Responsibilities of Grant Recipients

Recipients will be responsible for ensuring approval of projects by their campus administrator. Upon completion of the project or the end of the 2024 – 2025 school year, recipients will submit a final evaluation of the project and a description of how funds were utilized.
